

Welcome Pet Guidelines

Inside the Cottage & Grounds

Dogs are very welcome at the cottages, at a charge of £10 per dog per night.

- Dogs must be well-behaved, socially interactive and in good health.
- Please keep your dog on a lead & under control in all public areas.
- For the comfort of all our guests, we will ask owners to immediately remove any dog barking or causing a disturbance in the cottages.
- Please keep your dogs off the beds and furniture.
- The interior & grounds of the cottage must be left in a clean, undamaged condition
- Pets must be clean before they enter the cottage, particularly after wet & muddy walks – there is a hosepipe outside Police House Cottages and in the garden by Rose Cottages
- We reserve the right to apply a charge of £25 for any additional cleaning as a result of your dog's stay. Any damage to the cottage will be charged at the full replacement cost.

Out & About

Please help us look after our Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty by clearing up after your dog at all times and disposing of the waste in a bin – **even in wild areas or below the tide line.**

Please keep your dog under control around livestock & wildlife and follow the **Countryside Code.**

Our rare nesting birds & wild animals can be harmed by dogs running free on the dunes and beaches, particularly in the Spring & Summer, so please be alert for local signage.
